Overview

How much does electricity cost in Serbia?

Industry-specific and extensively researched technical data (partially from exclusive partnerships). A paid subscription is required for full access. In September 2024, the average wholesale electricity price in Serbia decreased to 107 euros per megawatt-hour from 127 euros per megawatt-hour the previous month.

What data formats are available for solar energy?

Solar resource (GHI, DNI, DIF, GTI, OPTA), PV power potential (PVOUT) and other parameters are provided in the form of raster (gridded) data in two formats: GeoTIFF and AAIGRID (Esri ASCII Grid). Provided data layers are in a geographic spatial reference (EPSG:4326).

How much energy does the EU consume per capita?

Energy consumption per capita amounts to 2.4 toe (22% below the EU average in 2021), including 4 500 kWh of electricity (22% below the EU average, 2021). Total energy consumption grew by 3.7%/year between 2019 and 2021 to 16.5 Mtoe.
