Successful bid price of container energy storage project in Greece 2025



Overview

Bids in the tender round were priced at between EUR 33,948 per MW and EUR 64,122 per MW, with the weighted average price of the successful proposals standing at EUR 49,748 per MW annually. Bids were capped at EUR 115,000 per MW per year.

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The average subsidy price in the third auction exercise came at €52589.16/MW/year. The lowest successful bid stood at €43927/MW/year, concerning a 25 MW/100 MWh project in the Western Macedonia region. The highest awarded subsidy came at €58773/MW/year and refers to a 7.9 MW/31.6 MWh project.

Seven companies have won government support for 11 standalone battery projects at Greece's second energy storage auction, where 300 MW was offered. Winners in the storage auction are CNI Energy with two 25 MW plants, Terna Energy with one of 40 MW, Heron with a 12 MW project, AMBER Energy with an.

Image by: Firm Power. The list released by the agency contains proposals launched by 42 developers for projects. How much does a new energy storage project cost in Greece?

The development is part of Greece's ongoing efforts to enhance its energy storage infrastructure. The average winning bid in this round is €46,680/MW per year. The list comprised proposals from 42 developers. However, bids amounting to 113MW from seven companies were not included in the competition.

How many projects have been awarded in Greece's first battery energy storage system?

The Greek Regulatory Authority for Energy has confirmed that 411.8 MW of projects have been awarded in the country's first standalone battery energy storage system (BESS) tender, which has attracted huge interest among developers. Investment and operating aid will be granted to 12 projects put forward by seven proponents.

How many MW of new battery storage capacity does Greece have?

The Greek authorities have awarded 300 MW of new battery storage capacity in its second energy storage tender. The 11 winning projects range in size from 8.875 MW/17.75 MWh to 49.9 MW/100 MWh.

What is the highest subsidy for a battery project in Greece?

The highest awarded subsidy came at €58773/MW/year and refers to a 7.9 MW/31.6 MWh project located in the same region. Greek firm Hellenic Renewables, which is a subsidiary of Helleniq Energy, offered the lowest successful bids for two battery projects of 25 MW/100 MWh each.

How many projects are being built in Greece?

Various Greek and regional European news outlets have in the past 24 hours reported that that list of 48 projects has since been whittled down to 11 winning projects totalling nearly 300MW of capacity.

Which energy projects remained below the line?

Two offers remained below the line: Alasia's two projects of 36 MW each and R1 Energy's planned unit of 50 MW. CNI's bid for a facility in Livadia was the lowest: EUR 44,100 per MW per year. The highest, at EUR 49,917 per MW per year, was for Terna's battery array in Thebes. The average was EUR 47,680 per MW per year.

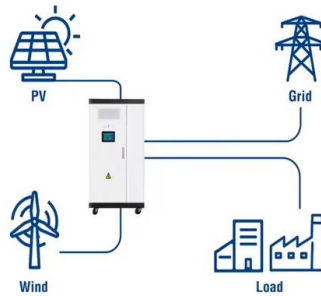

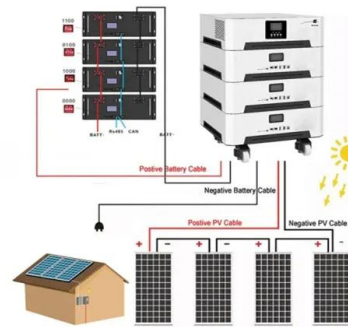

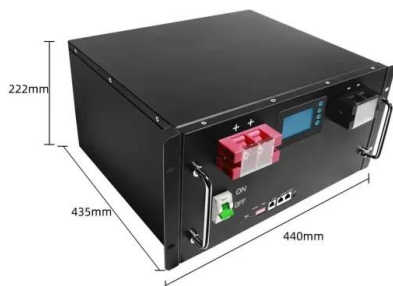
